Thank you for working with us as such short notice to either keep your child at home today or bring them into school this morning if they are eligible.

In-School Provision

As a reminder, your child can continue to attend school if you are a key worker or they are classes as vulnerable. Details of what the Government considers to be a critical worker are available here:

Initially children will be split into the following bubbles so that we can offer the best support to all children and minimise the risks of the virus spreading: EYFS, Y1/Y2, Y3/Y4 and Y5/Y6. Each bubble will be led by staff members who work in their classes usually.

In school provision will begin at 0800 and end at 1520. If you wish your child to attend Oasis Kids Club after school, which will run until 6pm, please notify both school and Oasis so we can prepare accordingly.

To secure your child a place in our in school provision, please complete the following form <https://forms.gle/2jRmLupqFPPKQsGL9> A booking form will need to be completed weekly so that we can ensure we are staffed accordingly.

School packed lunches will be available in place of usual school dinners at a cost of £3.20 unless you are In YR, Y1, Y2 or eligible for FSM in which case, they will be free.


School uniform does not need to be worn.

Remote Learning Provision

Every child is expected to continue to learn during this lockdown period. We appreciate that this provides additional challenges for some parents and we will support in any way that we can.

Each class teacher will post a weekly overview on a Monday which will outline the learning activities for the week. The daily resources and learning activities will be uploaded each morning. This will be done through Seesaw (Tapestry in Reception). If you have any issues with login details, lack of devices to access remote learning etc please contact your class teacher. It is expected that children will engage with their online learning each day.
