What to do if...	Action needed by family	Action taken by school	Return to school when...
My child has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school Keep any siblings home Self-isolate Get your child tested by ordering a test Inform school immediately about the test result 	Bubble to continue as normal	The test comes back negative
My child tests positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school Inform school immediately about the test result Self-isolate for at least 10 days 	Letter to be emailed and sent home to children from the class bubble. This group instructed to self isolate for 10 days, school to provide home learning	After 10 days, providing they are feeling better
Someone in my household has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school Self-isolate for 14 days Household member to get a test Inform school immediately about the test 	Home learning to be provided if isolating for 14 days. If FSM (not universal) School to provide lunch provision	The household member test is negative
Someone in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school Self-isolate for 14 days 	Home learning to be provided if isolating for 14 days. If FSM (not universal) School to provide lunch provision	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
NHS Test and Trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school Self-isolate for 14 days 	Home learning to be provided if isolating for 14 days. If FSM (not universal) School to provide lunch provision	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
We/my child has travelled and has to selfisolate as part of a period of quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel Provide information to school as per attendance policy <u>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed:</u> Do not come to school Contact school Self-isolate for 14 days 	Home learning to be provided if isolating for 14 days. If FSM (not universal) School to provide lunch provision	The quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
We have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact the Headteacher Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused 	Learning at home to be supported by school. If FSM (not universal) School to provide lunch provision	When you have received notification that it is safe to return to school
